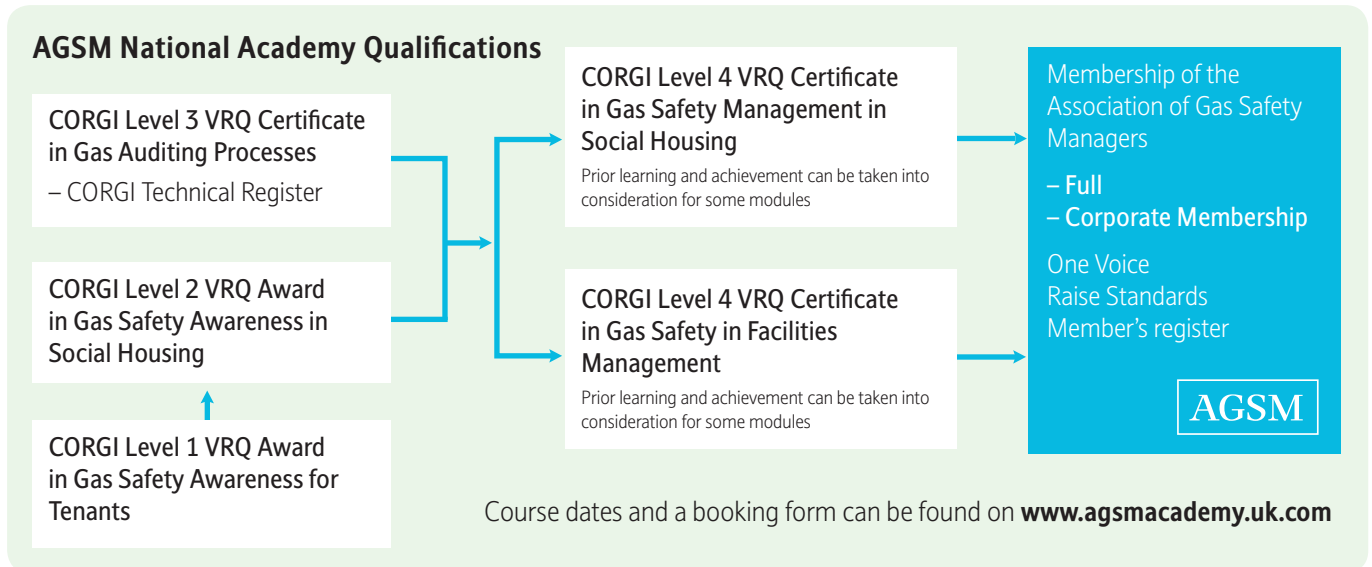
The qualification consists of six units:-

- **Flueing and Ventilation of Industrial & Commercial Gas Appliances**
An in-depth look at two of the most important aspects that determine the safe functioning of appliances
- **Industrial Gas Appliances, Meters and Pipework**
An understanding of the different types of appliances, meter and gas installations that are found in facilities management and estates
- **Commercial Catering Installations & Appliances**
An overview of a safe working environment within commercial catering
