The ASCP incorporates two specialist associations; the Association of Gas Safety Managers (AGSM) and the Association of Electrical Safety Managers and provides support, advice and guidance to members on gas, electrical, fire, legionella and asbestos safety. The ASCP also includes Women in Compliance, a support and mentoring scheme for females in the sector.

Our objectives
